### **Eligibility Criteria for YEC Scholarships**

- Must be working on or have completed career planning or job search activities with an Employment Counsellor at The City of Calgary Youth Employment Centre.
- Must plan to enroll in either an accredited postsecondary institution, apprenticeship, training or upgrading program for a minimum of one semester, within one year of this application.
- Must be between the ages of 15-24 years old.
- Must not have been a previous winner of the scholarship.
- Must not be related to an employee or be employed at the Youth Employment Centre.

#### **Selection Criteria**

All applications will be evaluated by a selection committee appointed by the Youth Employment Centre.

Scholarship recipient will be selected and notified in July.

Recipients will receive one cheque made payable to the educational institution selected for enrollment.
