

Ineligible occupations list

Post-Graduate Worker or International Graduate Categories

Under either the Employer-Driven Stream or Strategic Recruitment Stream

This list is to be used only to determine if your occupation is ineligible.

Please note that most occupations identified by the NOC as being skill level 0, A, B, or C are eligible.

- International/Post-Graduates are not eligible if working in a NOC skill level D.
- International/Post-Graduates in **engineering occupations** must apply under the Strategic Recruitment Stream – Engineering Occupations Category.
- International/Post-Graduates in **compulsory trade occupations** must apply under the Strategic Recruitment Stream – Compulsory and Optional Trades Category.

This list uses the 2006 National Occupational Classification (NOC) code and skill level.

If an applicant's current occupation's skill level changed from the 2006 NOC system to the 2011 NOC system, the application will be considered on the basis of the NOC code that is most beneficial to the applicant.
